FEEDBACK ANALYSIS OF PARENTS' PERCEPTION




Diagram-1: Shows the perception of parents about the present mode of teaching




Diagram-2: Shows the perception of parents about the course content.




Diagram-3: Shows the Perception of parents about the completion of the syllabus in each subject.

Significance: The majority (74.00%) of parents of K.D College perceive that teachers of the college complete the syllabus duly on time.




Diagram-4: Shows the perception of parents about time table convenient enough to their ward in attending his/her classes.

Significance: The majority (80.23%) of parents of the college perceive that time table is convenient enough for their ward in attending his or her classes.




Diagram-5: Shows the perception of parents about complaints from their ward regarding ancillary services like office and library services.

Significance: The majority (77.45%) of parents have no complaints from their ward about ancillary services like office and library services.




Diagram-6: Shows the perception of parents about the satisfaction of their ward with canteen services.

Significance: The majority (71.00%) of parents of the college perceive that their wards are satisfied with the canteen services.




Diagram-7: Shows whether parents encourage their ward in attending classes regularly.

Significance: The majority (94.51%) of parents of K.D. College encourages their ward in attending classes regularly.




Diagram-8: Shows parents encouraging their ward in participating in various types of co-curricular activities organized by the college/ affiliating university.




Diagram-1: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the contents of the curriculum.




Diagram-2: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the implementation of the curriculum

Significance: The majority (90.41%) of students of the college are highly satisfied with the implementation of the curriculum. 9.59% of students in the college bear an average level of perception.




Diagram-3: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the effectiveness of the curriculum for future prospects.




Diagram-4: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on convenience in complying with the time table




Diagram-5: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the utility of the internal assessments towards the preparation for the final examination




Diagram-6: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the availability of relevant books/ journals in the college library.




Diagram-7: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on service provided by the college library




Diagram-8: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the support extended by the college office

Significance: The majority (90.58%) of students of the college perceive that support extended by the college office is highly satisfactory. Office personnel of the college are very supportive.




Diagram-9: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the quality of food made available in the canteen




Diagram-10: Shows overall rating of students (% form) on the quality of other support services like recreation and hygiene facilities

Significance: The majority (82.56%) of students of the college perceive that the quality of other support services like recreation and hygiene facilities in the college are highly satisfactory.




Diagram-11: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the effectiveness of games & sports and cultural activities

Significance: The majority (80.43%) of students of the college well perceive the effectiveness of games & sports and cultural activities in the college.




Diagram-12: Shows overall rating of students (form) on the effectiveness of enrichment programmes offered by N.S.S., career & counseling cell, woman's study center.




Diagram-13: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the necessity of introducing new programs on communication skills




Diagram-14: Shows the overall rating of students (% form) on the necessity of introducing job-oriented professional courses




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of teachers by students' perception




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of teachers by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of the course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of the teacher while teaching.

Significance: The majority of students (87.8%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers teach with good self-confidence during classroom interaction.




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skills of the teacher during the teaching-learning situation.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to the latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.

Significance: All of the students (100%) of the Dept. perceive that all teachers help students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on the teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram 15: Shows students' perception on teacher respects the opinion of the student.




Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram-17: Shows students' perception on the teacher maintaining discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.

Significance: Tarun Kumar Chakraborty has the best time management skills, subject management skills & attitude.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of ACNH.




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of teachers by students' perception




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of teachers by students' perception




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of the course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of the teacher while teaching




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the Personality and communication skills of the teacher during the teaching-learning situation.

Significance: The majority of students (more than 85.7%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers are well-versed in the class.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.

Significance: The majority of students (88.7%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers are well-organised.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to the latest developments in the field.

Significance: The majority of students (more than equal 85%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers always refer to the latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.

Significance: The majority of students (83.2%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers help students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on the teacher respects the opinion of student.




Diagram - 16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.

Significance: More than equal 62.1% of students in the Dept. perceive that their teachers are always willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintains discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as a true mentor and role model in your life

Significance: 65.6% of students in the Dept. perceive that they trust their teacher as a true mentor and role model in their life.




Diagram 19: shows comparison on time management, subject management & attitude.

Significance: Sk. Sabbir Hossen in the Bengali Dept. has the best time management, subject management skills & attitude.





Diagram 20: Shows the overall average score of teachers in the Bengali Department.




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of teachers by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on self-confidence of the teacher while teaching.




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of the teacher during the teaching-learning situation.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on teacher respects the opinion of student.

Significance: 92.7% of students in the Dept. perceive that their teachers always respect the opinion of students.




Diagram - 16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.

Significance: 87% of students in the Dept. perceive that their teachers are always willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintains discipline without being too strict.

Significance: 92.7% of students in the Dept. perceive that their teachers always maintain discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as a true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.





Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of Economics.






Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of the course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of teacher while teaching.




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of the teacher during the teaching-learning situation.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on the teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on teacher respects the opinion of student.




Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintains discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as a true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of English.




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of teachers by students' perception




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of teachers by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of the course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of teacher while teaching




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of the teacher during the teaching-learning situation.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to the latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on teacher respects the opinion of student.




Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintains discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as a true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of MMH.




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of the teacher by students' perception




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of the teacher by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on completion of the course of teacher.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of teacher while teaching




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of teacher during teaching-learning situation.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to the latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on teachers respects the opinion of students.




Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teachers maintains discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teachers as true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of History.




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of teachers by students' perception




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of teachers by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of the course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of the teacher while teaching




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of the teacher during the teaching-learning process.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to the latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in the other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on the teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.






Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on the teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintains discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as a true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of Political Science.




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of the teacher by students' perception




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of the teacher by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on completion of the course in time.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on the Topic while teaching.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of the teacher while teaching




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of the teacher during the teaching-learning process.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refers to latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on the teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on the teacher respects the opinion of the student.




Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on the teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintain discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about acceptance of the teacher as a true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.

Significance: Sukhendu Bikash Giri has the best time management, subject management skills, and attitude.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of Computer Science.




Diagram-1: Shows the degree of punctuality of teachers by students' perception

Significance: The majority of regular students (87.5%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers in the Dept are very punctual.




Diagram-2: Shows the degree of regularity of teachers by students' perception.




Diagram-3: shows students' perception on the completion of the course of teachers.




Diagram-4: shows students' perception on focus on Topic while teaching.

Significance: All the students (100%) in the Dept. perceive that all teachers are well-focused on the syllabus during classroom interaction.




Diagram-5: shows students' perception on the self-confidence of teacher while teaching




Diagram-6: showing students' perception on the communication skill of teacher during the teaching-learning situation.




Diagram-7: showing students' perception on command on the topic and subject




Diagram-8: showing students' perception on organised teacher.




Diagram-9: shows students' perception on refer to latest developments in the field.




Diagram-10: shows students' perception on providing/referring to reading material/study material.




Diagram-11: showing students' perception on helping approach towards varied academic interests of students.




Diagram-12: showing students' perception on helping students in other aspects with an unbiased approach




Diagram-13: showing students' perception on helping students facing physical emotional and learning challenges.




Diagram-14: Shows students' perception on teacher encourages/gives information about future avenues of the subject.




Diagram: 15 Shows students' perception on teacher respects the opinion of student.




Diagram -16: Shows students' perception on teacher is willing to learn from the students.




Diagram: 17 Shows students' perception on teacher maintains discipline without being too strict.




Diagram 18: Shows students' perception about Acceptance of the teacher as true mentor and role model in your life




Diagram 19: Shows the comparison of time management, subject management & attitude of teachers.

Significance: Subhajit Barman has the best time management skills and subject management skills whereas, Avishek Bhunia and Abhinanda Bal have the best attitude.




Diagram 20: Shows overall average scores of teachers of Geography.
