


Diagram-2: Shows perception of parents about course content.




Diagram-3: Shows the Perception of parents about completion of syllabus in each subject.

Significance: Majority (78.68 %) parents of K.D College perceive that teachers of the college complete the syllabus duly in time.




Diagram-4: Shows perception of parents about time table convenient enough to their ward in attending his/her classes.

Significance: Majority (76.44 %) of parents of the college perceive that time table is convenient enough to their ward in attending his or her classes.




Diagram-5: Shows the perception of parent about complaints from their ward regarding ancillary services like office and library services.

Significance: Majority (70.36 %) of parents have no complaint from their ward about ancillary services like office and library services.




Diagram-6: Shows the perception of parent about satisfaction of their ward with canteen service.

Significance: Majority (70.35 %) of parents of the college perceive that their wards are satisfied with the canteen service.




Diagram-7: Shows whether parents encourage their ward in attending classes regularly.

Significance: Majority (96.45 %) of parents of K.D. College encourage their ward in attending classes regularly.




Diagram-8: Shows encourage their ward in participating in various types of co curricular activities organized by the college/ affiliating university.
